

Said Complaints will be heard before the Court of Common Pleas, Pickaway County, Ohio, Juvenile Division for an **Adjudication hearing at 1:15 PM on Thursday, November 21, 2019**, at the Pickaway County Courthouse, 207 South Court Street, Circleville, OH 43113. **Final Disposition will take place immediately thereafter if there is no objection by the parties and counsel.**

You are hereby notified that:

1. Any party is entitled to a lawyer in all proceedings in Juvenile Court. If a party cannot afford a lawyer and meets certain requirements, the Court will appoint one upon request. If you wish to have a lawyer but believe you cannot afford one, call Kaleigh Bower at the Court of Common Pleas, Pickaway County, Ohio, Juvenile Division at 740-474-3117 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM Monday through Friday or write the Court of Common Pleas, Pickaway County, Ohio, Juvenile Division at the Pickaway County Courthouse, 207 South Court Street, Circleville, OH 43113.
2. The granting of the Complaints' prayer or request for temporary custody will result in the Parent(s) losing physical and legal custody of the Minor Children until the Court terminates the order or permanently divests the Parent(s) of all parental rights.
3. The granting of an order of protective supervision to PCJFS may result in the Parent(s) continuing to have physical and legal custody of the Minor Children under the supervision of PCJFS until the Court terminates the order or grants temporary custody to PCJFS or another interested party.
